Itawamba takes out defending champion Parkland in opening game of NJCAA II World Series

Millington, Tenn. - Itawamba Community College (46-9) plated a run in the bottom of the tenth inning to defeat defending champion Parkland College (48-13) 3-2 to open the 2003 NJCAA Division II World Series in Millington, Tenn.

With one out in the bottom of the tenth, Kevin Caldwell reached on an infield single and advances to second on an overthrow by the shortstop. Two batters later, Marshal Faulkner singled to center to drive in Caldwell for the winning run.

Tim Dillard (11-0) earned the win with a 10-inning complete game. He scattered 11 hits and struck out 12 without walking a batter. David Smith took the loss for Parkland.

Caldwell led the offensive attack for Itawamba going 3-for-5 with a run and an RBI. Bryan Williamson recorded two hits for the Indians. Chris Malone led Parkland with three hits.

Itawamba advances to take on the winner of CCBC-Catonsville/Iowa Central at 3:00 p.m. Sunday. Parkland will take on the loser of that game at 9:00 a.m.
